



## Useful information regarding your lawncare treatment



### What can I expect from my lawncare treatment programme?

Our aim is to provide a beautiful healthy lawn for our customers by applying techniques, products and expertise used within the professional ground care industry.

With the combined effort of good care and regular maintenance from you, we hope to make your lawn the envy of your neighbours. Some improvement will be evident fairly quickly; however, it may take a full season or more to achieve the full benefit from your lawncare programme.

Lawncare is not an exact science as your lawn has its own character and requirements. Our technicians will keep a careful record of your lawn and will advise you on an individual and annual basis.

Remember that we will be working with Mother Nature and even the best kept lawn will suffer and turn brown without moisture during periods of drought. However a swift recovery will occur once significant rain has fallen.

### What treatments will I require?

Our technician will have carried out a free thorough analysis and report regarding the condition of your lawn together with our recommendations and associated prices.

You do not necessarily have to choose to carry out every treatment that we recommend, however we believe the selected treatments will make the best improvements.

As your lawn improves from season to season we will adjust your programme accordingly. Our technicians are always available to discuss any aspect of our treatment programme.

### Are treatments safe?

We only use professional products that are certified for amenity use.

We will always advise if there are any restrictions when using your lawn after our treatments have been applied.

### Do I need to sign a contract?

No. You may cancel any treatment at any time.

### How do I know when you are coming to carry out a treatment?

Due to our unpredictable weather we do not pre-book visits too far in advance, our treatments are tailored at approximately 10-12 week intervals.

You do not need to be at home when we visit, but we will require access to your lawn. Customers are usually happy for us to call when we are in your area when it is time for your treatment. However, in most cases we will phone ahead a day or two before to make an appointment.

### How soon can I mow after treatment?

We generally recommend that mowing is not carried out 2-3 days before and after treatment, but we will inform you when we call ahead and further instruction will be printed on your invoice on the day of treatment.

### Should I water after a treatment?

It is not essential that watering is carried out after fertiliser application, however if no rain has fallen after 2 or 3 days, watering will help assist nutrient take-up.

We do not recommend watering for 2-3 days if possible after we have applied herbicide to ensure a good take-up from targeted weeds.

If you irrigate your lawn regularly we recommend a once or twice per week thorough saturation during the early hours of the morning to be most effective. The little and often approach or regular over-watering will cause a shallow rooted lawn and encourages fungus problems such as red thread.

### What happens in future years?

Your treatment programme will continue from season to season unless you inform us of any change, but we will be in touch during the Winter months to discuss recommended changes to your programme.

- We will always inform you of any price changes.

### How do I pay?

In most cases we use a "pay as you go" method. We leave an invoice after each treatment and you can pay the technician or send a cheque in the post or pay by credit card.

We have a pre-pay system for annual treatments in advance if required.

March - early May



### Late Spring Treatments

May - early July



### Summer Treatments

July - early September



### Autumn Treatments

Mid August - November



### Winter Treatments

November - February
